Approved Workmen Are Not Ashamed (AWANA) is taken from II Timothy 2:15, which is our key verse. Our Goal is to "Get As Much of God's Word as Deep as We Can into the Hearts of as Many as We Can. We are looking forward to a great program for the 2025-26 year. We meet on Friday nights during the school year from 6:15-8:15 p.m. We try to take off approximately one Friday night a month to allow for family time. IMPORTANT NOTE: We have a new <u>Code of Conduct and Procedures</u> posted on the website as well. (They are also available in our foyer). Each parent or guardian will be required to agree to support the new code and procedures by signing no later than the second time your child attends.

Our Check In / Pick Up Procedures are posted with the Code of Conduct. Upon signing to pick up your children, you will be expected to stay with them. No unattended children on the playground and parking areas lot before or after Awana.

Below you will find the Schedule for our program. Please note, Awana night just prior to Thanksgiving and Christmas have a unique schedule to accommodate holiday centered activities. Watch our Awana webpage for additional information.

6:15 – 6:30 p.m. GAMES. We have an ever-widening array of age appropriate activities for the children.

6:30 – 6:50 p.m. EAT - We serve a light, kid-friendly meal at this point. *Please make us aware of any food allergies your child has on the registration form.

6:50 - 7:10 p.m. Opening Ceremony: Music, Welcome, Pledges

7:10 – 7:30 p.m. Bible Council Time – an age appropriate Bible Story

7:30 – 7:55 p.m. Handbook – Scripture Memorization

8:00 – 8:15 p.m. Closing Presentations, Awards, Announcements & prayer

Note: Children who arrive after Opening Ceremony has begun, may be asked to wait with a leader in the foyer so as not to disrupt prayer or Bible council time. They will be directed to enter at the earliest appropriate time.

<u>NEW CLUBBERS</u> - Will work from an Entrance book at no charge. Once it is complete, they will need a book and a uniform purchased for them.
