Letter to Parents/Guardians of RETURNING CLUBBERS

Approved Workmen Are Not Ashamed (AWANA) is taken from II Timothy 2:15, which is our key verse. Our Goal is to “Get As Much of God’s Word as Deep as We Can into the Hearts of as Many as We Can. We are looking forward to a great program for the 2025-26 year. We meet on Friday nights during the school year from 6:15-8:15 p.m. We try to take off approximately one Friday night a month to allow for family time. You can find the dates we meet on the first Registration page after clicking the link for Registration as well as other information we hope you find helpful on our website at gbcroserich.com/awana. If you registered for Fall, it is not necessary to register for Spring.

IMPORTANT NOTE: We continue to follow [Code of Conduct and Procedures](#) from fall. It is posted on the website as well. (They are also available in our foyer). Each parent or guardian will be required to agree to support the new code and procedures by signing each year no later than the second time your child attends. Please review these with your child before this semester is under way. It is only necessary to sign and submit these once a year.

[Our Check In / Pick Up Procedures](#) are posted with the Code of Conduct. *We will need a signed copy of our Check-In/Check-Out Procedures every semester by 2nd date of attendance.* Please continue to follow these to help us ensure safety. Upon signing to pick up your children, you will be expected to stay with them. No unattended children on the playground and parking areas lot before or after Awana.

Our schedule includes: Games, Worship, Pledges, Goals, Prayer, Bible Lesson, Memory Challenge Time and a Closing Celebration where children are encouraged and awarded for their hard work. We welcome parents to join us for closing at 8 pm by coming a little early to pick up their children. Parents are welcome to visit our program anytime.

Note: Children who arrive after Opening Ceremony has begun, may be asked to wait with a leader in the foyer so as not to disrupt prayer or Bible council time. They will be directed to enter at the earliest appropriate time.

We especially welcome parents to our Easter Sunday Worship Service where the children/youth will perform an Easter presentation as well as for our Awards Ceremony on the last night of Awana for the Year on Friday, May 1 at 6:15 p.m.

NEW CLUBBERS - Will work from an Entrance book at no charge. Once it is complete, they will need a book and a uniform purchased for them.

Note: Lost books or uniforms will incur replacement costs.

Cubbies 3 -5 years. Children must be potty-trained.

Sparks age 6 – 2nd Grade

T & T (Truth & Training) 3rd – 5th Grade

Trek – Middle Schoolers 6th – 8th Grade
